Chapter meeting will be 9-16,2020 @ 7:00 PM by zoom. Anyone is encouraged to attend. Our new VP is Joe Valenti from Council 1530.

Work with your Pastors. Sit down with him and ask how the Knights can serve the Church. Are there tasks that the Knights can do for the parish? If you suggest ideas for the Parish make sure you tell the Pastor we will do the work and it will be no cost to the Parish. Propose faith in Action programs that will benefit the Parish. Reach out to the Pastor, Take him to lunch and don't discuss business.

Encourage all members and their families to join the Father McGivney Guild.

We need to Invite new members to be part of the Knights of Columbus. Ask members of Parish, family, and friends. The new membership video is now available online. Each Council should have a Degree team in place.

Retention starts when a new member takes his degree in the Knights of Columbus. When a Knight is recruited he has a sponsor. If he becomes inactive, follow up with him. Review his survey and keep him involved in the Council. If a Knight is not used as part of the council he losses interest and becomes inactive. If he is on a committee assign him duties. Using his survey, Involve him in the the Faith in Action program.

Pass out Born a Man/ Become A Knight cards. This is the new Form 100. Everyone in the Council knows a POTENTIAL KNIGHT. Lets get STAR COUNCIL.

As you start a new year, ask these Questions. How effective is our Recruiting? Did we use the Council's full potential? How effective was our Faith in Action programs? Did we engage the Parish and Community? How can the lessons of this year be a template for the new year? Did we get recommendations from our previous Program Directors?

You will be starting meetings at the Church. We need to keep in mind that we follow all precautions to prevent the spread of Covid19. Check temps. Anyone that exceeds a temp of 100 should not be admitted. If food is being served control the distribution. Maintain social distancing and all to wear masks. Clean the facility after the meeting. Use hand sanitizer.

Provide an electronic meeting such as Zoom. Members that are at a higher risk may not want to come to social gatherings yet. they still deserve to participate in the meeting. Members that are left behind become inactive.

Start planning Faith in Action Activities. RSVP, Family of the Month, Coats for Kids, Virtual "Into the Breach" Bible study, Virtual Rosary, Food for Families, and Leave no Neighbor left Behind.
