Blue Mass will be held 11-13-2020 @ 7:00PM at St. Joseph [EY]. All Councils invite members of Firefighters and Police Officers that are members of your Council and Parish. Run this in your Church Bulletins and all members of your Council are invited to the Mass. This is a 4th degree event but the Mass is open to all Knights of Columbus members and members of your parishes.

Special Olympics is an event that has replaced ARC. All councils put on your agenda to raise donations for the Special Olympics.

Soccer and Free Throw Challenges will be held again this year. As soon as dates are available they will be forwarded to you. Start making preparation and advise me if your council plans on entering the competition. Supporting personal are also needed to execute these events.
