K of C Scholarships

Scholarship applications for the 2012-2013 State Scholarship Program are in the possession of our Grand Knight. Your son or daughter must be a graduating senior in high school this year to be eligible for a \$2,000 State Scholarship. You can pick up an application from Pat Workinger. The deadline is December 31, 2013 for all the applications to be received by the State Scholarship Chairman. Please note that the application requires several signatures (principal, pastor, Grand Knight, and Financial Secretary), so the council would like to have the paperwork in by November 15 if at all possible.

FOOTBALL AND C.O.A.L. SWEEPSTAKES STARTING

The football sweepstakes and Chance of a Lifetime (C.O.A.L.) fundraisers have started. The football sweepstakes is a game of chance. The tickets are \$10. The contest lasts for ten weeks from October 27th to December 29th. Each ticket has four football team names randomly selected for each week.
